
Overview


Select question type




Options

2. Click on the Next button.




Answers

Tip: Click on the **Remove** button to delete an answer.


- 2. Enter eachanswer, enter the correct answer(s) in separate **Answer** textboxes.

- 2. Enter incorrect response feedback in the **Incorrect Response Feedback** textbox.




Categories and Keywords (optional)

Add a new topic/category/level of difficulty/keyword:


- 1. Click on the Add button.

- 3. Select a word from the dropdown list.




Tip: Click on the **(x)** button to delete a topic/category/level of difficulty/keyword.
