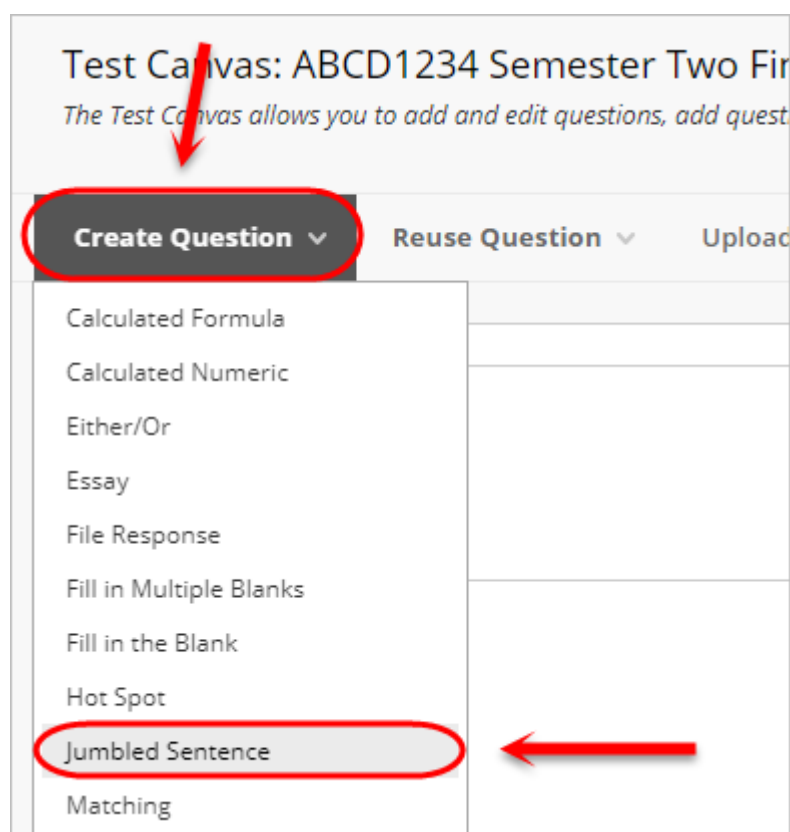
Overview

Example question

In the year 122 AD, the Roman Emperor Hadrian **[visited]** his provinces in Britain. On his visit, the Roman soldiers **[told]** him that Pict tribes from Britain's north had **[attacked]** them. So Hadrian **[gave]** the order to build a protective wall across one of the narrowest parts of the country.


1. Enter a **title** for the question in the **Question Title** textbox.




